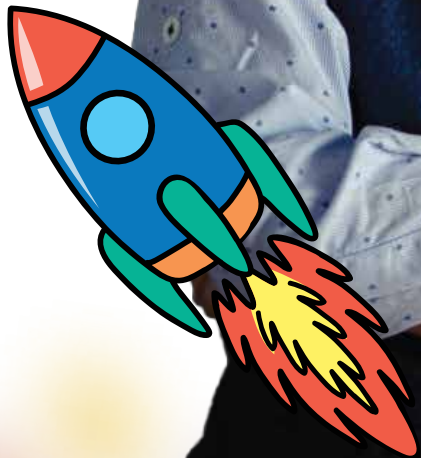

Themes: Animals, Nature, Emotions, Opposites

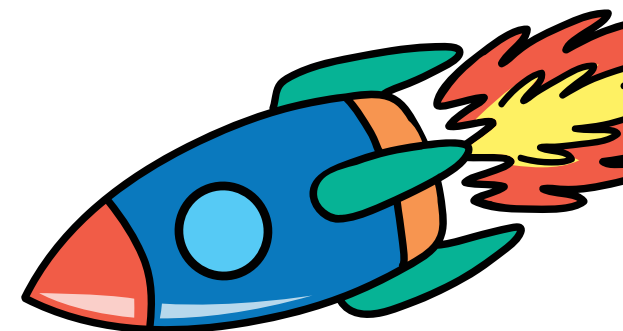
